



## Round 10

### Cadets

#### ***Heat 1***

The race proceedings started off with the cadet race one and Samuel Cunliffe made his pole position start count as he took the race win after leading the whole race. Saul Robinson and Jordan Cain managed to gain positions on the circuit which would have certainly helped in the championship.

#### ***Heat 2***

Jordan Cain and Luke Jenkinson battled through in race two for first and second place after starting on the grid in the same order. Jacob Eden being chased by Samuel Cunliffe managed to make his way up the order to third place from a fifth place grid start.

#### ***Heat 3***

Saul Robinson took the victory in race three after starting from the back of the grid. David Cuckson had a race to forget after starting in pole position he moved down the field and eventually settled for fifth position. Michael Borrows showed that he is getting to grips with the inkart championship by moving through the field and found himself setting the pace at the front. The pressure was being mounted by Saul Robinson and an untimely error cost Michael his first place finish. Michael had a fantastic race and finished in second.

#### ***Heat 4***

There were few overtakes in race four as Saul Robinson took the race win to seal back to back victories. Morgan Wroot lost out from his second place start and finished in fifth place. This allowed Oliver Royer to move up in to second place.

#### ***Heat 5***

Luke Jenkinson put on a dominant display in the final heat race, moving from fifth on the grid in to first place and took maximum points. Michael Burrows again took a second place finish to cap off a good performance in the heat stages. David Cuckson managed to earn some valuable points back this time starting at the back of the grid made his way in to fifth place.

### ***B Final***

For the B final six drivers took to the starting grid. Ioan Evans just missed out on place in the A final by one point but did earn the pole position start. Jacob Eden started alongside who tied for points with Ioan. Ioan set the pace through the fifteen laps and managed to maintain a gap in the lead of five seconds. The win of the B final earned Ioan a chance to battle for a podium finish.

### ***A Final***

Saul Robinson collected 35 from a possible 36 points from the heat stages and earned his pole position start for the grand final. Luke Jenkinson started alongside. While Jordan Cain and Samuel Cunliffe started in third and fourth place after being tied on points. Jordan Cain got off to a bad start and lost positions to Samuel Cunliffe and Michael Burrows in the first corners. Jordan had his work cut out for him in fifth place and did not manage to recover any positions. Michael Burrows tried to keep up with Samuel Cunliffe but found the gap getting bigger and bigger. By the chequered flag Michael was five seconds down on Samuel but a fourth place finish will seem almost like a victory in only his second round of Inkart. Saul Robinson finished off the inkart round in good fashion with another race win and only dropped one point in all of racing.

# **Juniors**

## ***Heat 1***

## ***Heat 3***

Daniel Taylor could only manage the one position gain in the final and settled for a sixth place finish.
