Heat 1

Heat 1 saw Liam Yarwood on pole position, Jonathon Yates and Alex Whipday rounding out the top 3. Alex Whipday made a good start immediately taking the lead

of the race. Liam dropped down the pack finishing in 5th place while Michael Burrows had a good race from 7th to 2nd. Alex took the race win by 4.3 seconds with Michael

and Logan rounding out the top 3 with Eric just missing out in 4th.

Heat 2

Michael Burrows on pole for heat 2 ahead of Logan Parker and Eric Su. A very straight forward race with Michael pulling out a 2

second lead over Logan, taking the race win, with Eric a further 4 second behind. The only position change was Alex Whipday overtaking

Joe Slamon to take 4th position.

Heat 3

The front row for heat 3 comprised of Logan Parker and Liam Yarwood with Joe and Jonathon on row 2. Joe appeared to struggle dropping back immediately, Michael again made a good

start to get himself up into 2nd position. Alex and Eric also came through the pack into 3rd and 4th from the last grid spots. Logan took the race win by just over 1 second with Michael and Eric

crossing the line with just over half a second between them.

Heat 4

Alex was on pole for heat 4 just ahead of Eric and Michael Burrows. Just a few position changes in heat 4. Michael found his way past

Eric to take 2nd place and Logan Parker put in a good race to finish 4th position after starting 7th. Good lap-times in heat 4 with a fastest lap of

33.594 going to Eric Su.

The Final

Michael Burrows qualified on pole position for the final with Alex Whipday starting alongside him. Logan Parker in 3rd place made a good start to get ahead of Alex Whipday before moving into the lead of the race on lap 3. Michael looked to be struggling in this final diving for the inside of corners, forcing himself wide on the exit giving the other drivers an easy opportunity to overtake. Michael lost out to Alex and Eric knocking him out of the podium positions. Logan Parker took the race

win by a tiny 0.384 seconds ahead of Alex Whipday who was a further 2.8 seconds ahead of Eric Su. Michael

came home in 4th position ahead of Jonathon Yates, Joe Slamon and Liam Yarwood.
